

## CSCP Book II Dictionary Help

Welcome to the new-look CLC Book II dictionary!

Here is some help to get you started finding your way round it:

### Searching

To look up a word in the dictionary, start typing in the search box (no need to type macra). If you have the **'search start'** toggle active, you will find Latin words that **start** with what you type. For example, if you type in 'adi', you will find *adeō* because the third principal part *adiī* starts with 'adi' as well as *adiuvō* where all parts start with 'adi':

If the **'search start'** toggle is set to off, you will find words that have your search term anywhere within the Latin dictionary entry. For example, the letters 'adi' will retrieve *clādēs*, *clādīs* and *gladiātor*, *gladiātōris* etc. because they also contain 'adi'.

When you find the word you want, you can look at a table of its different forms (if it has different forms) by clicking on 'Declension' or 'Conjugation' underneath it:

Click again on 'Conjugation' or 'Declension' to hide the table of forms.

You can also listen to the pronunciation of the Latin dictionary entry by clicking on the audio button:

## Showing and Hiding Columns

If you click on the 'Columns' button, you can choose to show further information about each Latin dictionary entry. Click or unclick each checkbox to show or hide information.

You can show which exam boards list an entry in their GCSE Latin vocabulary list:

You can show the CLC stage in which a word appears in a checklist (if it does appear in a checklist):

Finally, you can show whether each word appears in the Dickinson Latin Core vocabulary list. This shows the 1000 most frequently occurring words (in their various forms) in Latin giving each a rank from 1 to 1000 in order of frequency of use. These ranks or 'Dickinson Number's can be shown by clicking the rightmost text box:

## Filtering

When you click on the Filters button, you can filter dictionary entries to show only one word type or those in a particular exam board list or CLC checklist or only those that have a Dickinson Number. You can apply more than one filter at a time.

You can, for example, select only nouns or only WJEC level 1 words:



## Sorting

Latin dictionary entries can be sorted alphabetically, by stage in which they appear in a checklist (words that are not in a checklist appear at the end) and by Dickinson Number (words without a Dickinson Number appear at the end). Click the Sort button and then select the sort you want from the dropdown menu:




